So you must invest in yourself, this is the to be part!

To be all that God has called you to be requires investing in yourself,

How to invest in yourself:

- 1. Read daily...not only devotional but leadership materials..even one page a day!
- 2. Listen daily...in your car!
- 3. Thinking moments..set aside time weekly to think about leadership and your personal growth
- 4. Visit great places...i.e. a pastor of a church of 200 visiting a church that has 600..
- 5. Talk to greater leaders...who in your life is three or four laps ahead of you ask to meet with them regularly
- 6. Be committed to lifelong coaching or mentoring... a leader must always be ahead of their team...or they will cease to lead at some point...the student will become the master!
- 7. Create a plan and stick with it!

The greatest obstacle to personal growth isn't ignorance or lack of intelligence. it is a lack of a plan to get you there

Keys to creating a personal growth plan:

- Identify what you need
- Place it in your calendar and live by it!

Remember this ...if you are meeting a coach or mentor, the agenda travels up! in other words bring questions!

Develop a minimum "Personal Growth Plan"

Questions you could ask yourself:

•	How much time will I dedicate to reading each day/week?
•	How much time will I listen to teachings on leadership each day/week?
•	Will I have a coach in my life
•	Will I attend conferences or trainingsif so how many a year

Second.. What has God called you to do....

You must own your Present Responsibilities NOW!

Jesus call us as people to be His servants and disciples...And Jesus has entrusted us with gold/talents ...and we are responsible to use and develop them.. which is what leadership is all about...

Context: Jesus is giving examples of how Kingdom leadership works...He entrust his wealth, (Kingdom wealth) to his servant (leaders) to invest and grow the wealth...

Matthew 25:14 "Again, it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted his wealth to them. ¹⁵ To one he gave five bags of gold, to another two bags, and to another one bag, each according to his ability. Then he went on his journey.

- Jesus gives gifts to his leaders according to present ability...or skill..
- And... He expects their skill level to increase...

¹⁶ The man who had received five bags of gold went at once and put his money to work and gained five bags more. ¹⁷ So also, the one with two bags of gold gained two more. ¹⁸ But the man who had received one bag went off, dug a hole in the ground and hid his master's money.

• They are given time for their work to be shown for what it is...

¹⁹ "After a long time the master of those servants returned and settled accounts with them. ²⁰ The man who had received five bags of gold brought the other five. 'Master,' he said, 'you entrusted me with five bags of gold. See, I have gained five more.'

²¹ "His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!' ²² "The man with two bags of gold also came. 'Master,' he said, 'you entrusted me with two bags of gold; see, I have gained two more.'

²³ "His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!'

- Though their capacities were not equal..they each produced double..... the master was pleased...
- Except one...

²⁴ "Then the man who had received one bag of gold came. 'Master,' he said, 'I knew that you are a hard man, harvesting where you have not sown and gathering where you have not scattered seed.

²⁵ So I was afraid and went out and hid your gold in the ground. See, here is what belongs to you.'

- He looked at the gift as a trick of the master...to hurt him...
- His fear of how he perceived the master...led him to decide to bury what he had been given..... to do nothing with it!

²⁶ "His master replied, 'You wicked, lazy servant! So you knew that I harvest where I have not sown and gather where I have not scattered seed? ²⁷ Well then, you should have put my money on deposit with the bankers, so that when I returned I would have received it back with interest.

- His master called him on his reasoning...it was a lie...for if he truly believed that...he would have acted in a way to at least earn interest..
- The truth was he was wicked...wrong...a bad leader
- and was lazy...He would not put in the work to make something prosper..
- The master expected him to produce...it was a given ...
- His failure was to believe he would not be held accountable for doing nothing with what was entrusted to him, and that his blaming the master would be an acceptable excuse for doing nothing.

²⁸ "So take the bag of gold from him and give it to the one who has ten bags. ²⁹ For whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them.

- This actually was a test...
- There is a leadership saying that is most important..
 - You first have to get the right people on the bus and the wrong people off the bus.
 - o Then get the right people in the right seats...
 - o Then get the bus going... this is what Jesus did...

• The master got the right people on the bus...the first group of servants

³⁰ And throw that worthless servant outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'

- The master Got the wrong person off the bus...the lazy servant
- Got the right person in the right seat...Gave the 10 bagger the additional bag
- put the crier and the complainer with the other criers and complainers... no room for them on the bus!

What can we learn here about this leader's fall:

- 1) A position of leadership is more fragile than we might believe. As noble as our intentions might be as we assume a position of leadership or responsibility, we are always one errant, unthinking action or careless word from getting outside the boundaries of good judgment or even the moral absolutes that must frame all decisions.
- 2. <u>Complacency</u> Three servants given responsibility...two grew one was complacent... "There are many repercussions when a leader ceases to grow also. One is that the followers do not grow also and you will ultimately lose them... You cannot lead people farther than you have gone yourself. Also vision is no longer there. Instead fights begin. When people are no longer developing, they start to quarrel and complain."
- 3) <u>Arrogance</u> or misguided confidence...he confidently believed his own were the best solution to the issue at hand...they were not!
- 4) <u>He missed the warning signals</u>...He knew his master would expect increase...He was warned and did nothing about it.
- 5)<u>He rationalized his behavior</u>...He rationalized or convincingly lied to himself about his behavior and also believed he could minimize any feedback from his master.
- 6) <u>Derailed his leadership position</u>...he was not faithful with a few things...bag of gold...what he had was taken from him...

Conclusion a Successful leader takes ownership of their Responsibilities!
