Your IDENTITY starts with God.

Intimacy is the Journey - not the Destination - Ps 139

1. <u>He Knows You</u> – vs. 1-6

vs. 1-4: O LORD, you have searched me and you know me. 2You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. 3 You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. 4 Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O LORD. 5 You hem me in — behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me. 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.

<u>1Cor. 13:12</u>: "...Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known." <u>1Cor. 8:3</u>: "But the man who loves God is known by God." <u>Gal. 4:9</u>: "But now that you know God--or rather are known by God …"

2. <u>He is With You</u> – vs 7-12

vs 7 -12: Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? **8** If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. **9** If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, **10** even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast. **11** If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me and the light become night around me," **12** even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to you.

3. <u>He Made You</u> – vs. 13-16

<u>verses 13-16</u>: For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. *14* I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. *15*My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place. When I was woven together in the depths of the earth, *16* your eyes saw my unformed body. All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

4. <u>He Loves You</u> – vs. 17-18

<u>Vs. 17-18</u>: How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them! Were I to count them, they would outnumber the grains of sand. When I awake, I am still with you.

5. Only God Can Fully Know, Change and Fulfill You – vs. 23-24

<u>vs. 23-24</u> Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.
