COL 3:1 Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God's right hand. <sup>2</sup> Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth.NLT

What are the things Paul says to set our minds on?? The realities of Heaven and the abode of God and the throne of the Father and Jesus... do you know over 17 times Throne of God mentioned in the New Testament...it is the seat of all power, judgment, grace, rewards...absolute control...

• We are to think on such realities ... You know what a definition of a mentally healthy person is? One who is in touch with reality and Paul tells us to focus ... set our sight on the reality of Heaven...

So today lets examine some of those realities...to keep our minds on...

• First of all know this those in Heaven seems seem to have their minds set on us!'

NLT HEB 12:1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us.

- The witnesses surrounding us... Their rooting for us is not based on ignorance but perspective.
- They have run the same race themselves...and know the result of finishing...for they live in heaven...and experience the presence of Jesus
- They understand the supernatural in a way we cannot..
- So though they are retired from here, but they are not idly watching but intently observing... interacting on our behalf...cheering us on to keep running the race ... And we are to strip off the weights of sin that hinders us...by tripping up our feet...or our walk

They find great joy witnessing God continuously at work on Earth, in and through the saints witnessing the race he has marked out for us to run...and them knowing he will get us to the finish...

So though they are retired from here, but they are not idly watching but intently observing... interacting on our behalf...cheering us on to keep running the race ... And we are to strip off the weights of sin that hinders us...by tripping up our feet...or our walk

• Jesus used a story on earth to illustrate this truth about heaven's inhabitants watching and cheering

sheep and one of them gets lost, what will he do? Won't he leave the ninety-nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it? <sup>5</sup> And when he has found it, he will joyfully carry it home on his shoulders. <sup>6</sup> When he arrives, he will call together his friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost sheep.' <sup>7</sup> In the same way, there is more joy in heaven over one lost sinner who repents and returns to God than over ninety-nine others who are righteous and haven't strayed away! . NLT

- just as information was shared by the shepherd who looked for and found his lost sheep about the recovery of a lost lamb causing much rejoicing among his friends and neighbors......
- they also spread the news...to other neighbors and friends...the witnesses..
- it also implies they have joy for the 99...who are have not gotten lost

# \*\*\*\*\*Another scriptural example...

NLT LK 9: 28 About eight days later Jesus took Peter, John, and James up on a mountain to pray. <sup>29</sup> And as he was praying, the appearance of his face was transformed, and his clothes became dazzling white. <sup>30</sup> Suddenly, two men, Moses and Elijah, appeared and began talking with Jesus. <sup>31</sup> They were glorious to see. And they were speaking about his exodus from this world, which was about to be fulfilled in Jerusalem. <sup>32</sup> Peter and the others had fallen asleep. When they woke up, they saw Jesus' glory and the two men standing with

him. <sup>33</sup> As Moses and Elijah were starting to leave, Peter, not even knowing what he was saying, blurted out, "Master, it's wonderful for us to be here! Let's make three shelters as memorials—one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah."

- Moses and Elijah...appeared in glorious, physical bodies although Moses died Elijah was taken up to heaven in a whirlwind...bodily.....yet they both appeared in physical form... How do we know? Peter wanted to build them a shelter...
- they were standing...not floating like a spirit
- Moses and Elijah...spoke to Jesus about things...they spoke with knowledge of things taking place and about to take place on the earth...

\*\*\*\*\*And After Jesus was crucified...some others returned to being participants... before moving to witness..

NLT MT 27:50 Then Jesus shouted out again, and he released his spirit. <sup>51</sup> At that moment the curtain in the sanctuary of the Temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. The earth shook, rocks split apart, <sup>52</sup> and tombs opened. The bodies of many godly men and women who had died were raised from the dead. <sup>53</sup> They left the cemetery after Jesus' resurrection, went into the holy city of Jerusalem, and appeared to many people.

• These people were aware of the day and ....and resurrected with some type of heavenly/earthly bodies... as they were able to appear and disappear.

• Their memories were intact...as they were familiar with the city and they chose who they would appear too...and afterward apparently went to heaven..

# \*\*\*\*Which moves us to what's going on in Heaven

Around 94AD John was on the exiled to the island of Patmos...and on this island he was given a vision of heaven...and things taking place and a particular conversation between the Lord and saints who have died as martyrs...and he records their conversation ....

NLT Rev 6:9 When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of all who had been martyred for the word of God and for being faithful in their testimony. <sup>10</sup> They shouted to the Lord and said, "O Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long before you judge the people who belong to this world and avenge our blood for what they have done to us?"

There are a number of things we see here...

- 1. Those who died were relocated to the abode of God and were in the Temple with God...
- 2. Those were the same ones who died for him on earth...are now living with Him in Heaven
- 3. They are the same individuals who lived on earth...they have not changed into someone different...
- 4. They are fully cognizant of their life on earth and in particular the cause of their deaths ...their memory and history on earth was not erased.... and fully aware of what is going on in the earthly realm

- 1. So Your memory is not erased in Heaven...in fact it will be crystal clear...
- 2. They remembered they were martyred for Jesus...and who did it.
- 3. they communicated this to God in shouting....so their emotions were fully intact ....they spoke audibly...they could adjust their volume
- They spoke as one ... communication between them was normal.. and there was unity and harmony...
- though they cried out as one...each is aware of their own individual history...
- These people did not know everything....as they were still asking questions to the Lord...they were still in the process of learning...
- As "How Long" was their call...the current Heaven bound people are all aware of "time"...and the present Heaven has a time element.....
- How long till you judge? Oh Sovereign Lord...the one who is in charge and the one who is holy and true... THE PERFECT JUDGE... Justice is always the cry of God's people .....

# what happened next....

NLT Rev. 6: 11 Then a white robe was given to each of them. And they were told to rest a little longer until the full number of their brothers and sisters [f]—their fellow servants of Jesus who were to be martyred—had joined them.

- they were given a robe...they have a body a physical form of a different type...but yet they are clothed...
- they must wit longer for Justice...as there are more coming...who will need justice also.

# \*\*\*\*But there are other inhabitants in heaven along with the humans.....ANGELS

Heb 1:14 Therefore, angels are only servants—spirits sent to care for people who will inherit salvation

- The patriarch Jacob, in a dream, saw how this takes heavenly earthly interaction takes place...
- He saw angels traveling back and forth from the earth to God's presence in heaven

NLT Gen 28:11 At sundown he arrived at a good place to set up camp and stopped there for the night. Jacob found a stone to rest his head against and lay down to sleep. <sup>12</sup> As he slept, he dreamed of a stairway that reached from the earth up to heaven. - Jesus tells this story about angels...who also have emotions

# These Angels are still active today

- and told to wait longer... and they have a family connection....until all the rest of the servants and brothers are brought in.... then he will judge...
- Now these many people are talking to Jesus or what we call prayer...and they are aware of what is going on the earth and they are concerned...or what we would call interceding ....
- And Jesus know the exact number and the details of every one of them.....
- How long until you make it stop....is their cry...

Voice of the Martyrs estimates there are 150,000 people a year who lose their lives because of their testimony for Jesus. that is more than 400 a day... there are a lot of voices crying out....

- that is one glimpse of what is happening in heaven....and Scripture indicates there is much more going on in heaven besides this glimpse...
- scripture speaks of music, and singing, and worship and books and food...and as we read earlier it is a city....that is still undergoing construction...

when Jesus was ready to relocate back to where he came from...he told his disciples this...

JN 14:1 "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me. <sup>2</sup> In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a

place for you. <sup>3</sup> And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. <sup>4</sup> You know the way to the place where I am going."

- Jesus' Father has a house for his children...in a particular location...
- and Jesus is going there to add on to it...this has to be physical in some way....
- He will come back to take them there...to be with Him

#### **SO...**

- o Jesus who has a Physical body after he rises from the dead...
- is going to a place that can only be described as Physical...Location where his Father has a house... There will be spectacular places for each of us
- and in that house he is preparing each of them a place to live...
- He will come back to get them so they may be where he is and the others are...

and we will live eternally with God and those who know Him ... This place is our intermediate home....with God ...The Bible tells us that Heaven is a beautiful place.....that Jesus is continually adding to and making even better.

• Thomas like many of us do not understand what place Jesus is speaking about... ask How do we get there from here??? Great question...

JN 14:5 Thomas said to him, "Lord, we don't know where you are going, so how can we know the way?"

**Jesus Answered...** JN 14:6 I answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

- you can only get to my Father's house through me...
- you see heaven is not our default destination...we don't automatically get there...
- our default destination is separation from God....this is our problem...our soloution come to Jesus...
- the solutions is a person...the destination is a place...
- Jesus said this to the thief on the cross...who turned to him and asked him to take him to his kingdom...

LK 23:40 But the other criminal rebuked him. "Don't you fear God," he said, "since you are under the same sentence? <sup>41</sup> We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong." LK 23:42 Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." LK 23:43 Jesus answered him, "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in <u>paradise.</u>" PARADISE...an enclosed garden...walled park... and Paul visited this same place,...

<sup>2CO 12: 2</sup> I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know--God knows. <sup>3</sup> And I know that this man--whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, but God knows-- <sup>4</sup> was

caught up to paradise. He heard inexpressible things, things that man is not permitted to tell.

• interesting that he could not tell if he was in a physical state or not...but knew it was different ...but not that different..

#### What I know about Gabe in heaven so far....

Won't he leave the ninety-nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it? <sup>5</sup> And when he has found it, he will joyfully carry it home on his shoulders. <sup>6</sup> When he arrives, he will call together his friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost sheep.' <sup>7</sup> In the same way, there is more joy in heaven over one lost

sinner who repents and returns to God than over ninety-nine others who are righteous and haven't strayed away!

- When the one who has left the boundaries and strayed...Jesus goes and finds them...and His fiends and neighbors in heaven...the people rejoice
- But not only them ...the angels too..

<sup>8</sup> "Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Won't she light a lamp and sweep the entire house and search carefully until she finds it? <sup>9</sup> And when she finds it, she will call in her friends and neighbors and say, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost coin.' <sup>10</sup> In the same way, there is joy in the presence of God's angels when even one sinner repents."

Heaven is also the place where angels interact with God and receive instructions from him. The patriarch Jacob, in a dream, saw angels traveling back and forth from the earth to God's presence (Genesis 28:12 - 17).

HEB 13:1 Keep on loving each other as brothers. <sup>2</sup> Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it.

### Matthew 18:10

#### The Parable of the Wandering Sheep

"See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that their **angels** in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven.

### Matthew 24:31

And he will send his **angels** with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

#### Matthew 26:53

Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels?

#### The New Jerusalem

The last two chapters of the Bible describe a glorious New Jerusalem that will descend on the planet from God's throne in heaven (Revelation 21:10). It will be a magnificently beautiful city built from pure gold that is clear like glass. Its walls will look like jasper and contain twelve foundation stones, composed of various gems, that have the names of the original twelve apostles inscribed on them (Revelation 21:18 - 21).

God the Father, after the city is taken from heaven and placed on the earth, will then do something he has never done before! He will personally place his and Jesus' throne within the New Jerusalem (Revelation 21:22 - 22:3)! He will make the city the new center and capital of the entire universe.

God's awesome plan to create beings like himself, which started in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 1:26 - 27), will finally be complete. He can now share eternity with his children and interact face-to-face with all those who were saved (Revelation 21:24, 26, 22:4) and forever enjoy their company. The placement of their thrones within a New Jerusalem will constitue heaven on earth!

#### three scriptural examples...there are more...

LK 9:28 About eight days after Jesus said this, he took Peter, John and James with him and went up onto a mountain to pray. <sup>29</sup> As he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became as bright as a flash of lightning. <sup>30</sup> Two men, Moses and Elijah, <sup>31</sup> appeared in glorious splendor, talking with Jesus. - they were standing...not floating like a spirit
- Moses and Elijah...spoke to Jesus about things..they spoke with knowledge of things taking place and about to take place on the earth...

#### and when Jesus was crucified...

MT 27:50 And when Jesus had cried out again in a loud voice, he gave up his spirit. MT 27:51 At that moment the curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth shook and the rocks split. The tombs broke open and the bodies of many holy people who had died were raised to life. They came out of the tombs, and after Jesus' resurrection they went into the holy city and appeared to many people.

- these people were aware of the day....and resurrected with bodies...
- interacted with people on the earth....then apparently went to heaven..

Around 94AD John was on the exiled to the island of Patmos...and on this island he was given a vision of heaven...and things taking place and things that were going to take place on the earth...

and he speaks of the saints who have died as martyrs...and he records their conversation with God....

REV 6:9 When he (Jesus) opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God and the testimony they had maintained. <sup>10</sup> They called out in a loud voice, "How long, Sovereign Lord, holy and true, until you judge the inhabitants of the earth and avenge our blood?" <sup>11</sup> Then each of them was given a white robe, and they were told to wait a little longer, until the number of their fellow servants and brothers who were to be killed as they had been was completed.

There are a number of things we see here...

- 5. Those who died were relocated to the abode of God and were in the Temple with God...
- 6. those were the same ones who died for him on earth...now live with Him in Heaven
- 7. they are the same they have not changed...
- 8. they are distinct individuals...
- 9. They are fully cognizant of what happened to them...their memory and history on earth was not erased.... and fully aware it is still going on....
- 10. which means they remembered their life on earth...

## Stephen the first recorded martyr in Acts...looked up into Heaven...

AC 7:54 When they heard this, they were furious and gnashed their teeth at him. 55 But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, looked up to heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus

standing at the right hand of God. <sup>56</sup> "Look," he said, "I see heaven open and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."

• Those present in the Temple undoubtedly watching also... which makes sense..because at the final judgment...not the salvation judgment...we will all give an account of our lives...

RO 14:9 For this very reason, Christ died and returned to life so that he might be the Lord of both the dead and the living. <sup>10</sup> You, then, why do you judge your brother? #### why?

<sup>2 CO 5:12</sup> Now we see but a poor reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known.

so how ought we to live in the mean time?

<sup>2</sup> CO 5:9 So we make it our goal to please him, whether we are at home in the body or away from it. <sup>10</sup> For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive what is due him for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad.

This is an ignorance that we are responsible for, but it is ignorance, and without that ignorance we would not sin. In Heaven, in the presence of God, overwhelmed and filled with the total joy of goodness, baptized with goodness as a sunken ship is filled with water, no one could possibly ever want to turn from this perceived glory. Now, "we walk by faith, not by sight" (2 Cor. 5:7).

Heavenly sight increase our freedom. Ask the blind whether sight would remove their freedom.

when we live for heaven ... our lives on earth change....

<sup>1CO 15:58</sup> Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

- the reason to stand firm is that all labor done with the consciousness of God will be rewarded...
- every good acts builds up reward for you in heaven... if we believe that this life is the preparation for eternity, then everything makes an eternal difference.
- Historically, it is those who have believed most strongly in Heaven who have made the greatest difference to Earth, beginning with Christ himself.

- we will give an account...
- I think eternity will include all time, as we see their whole life pass before them in perfect temporal order, not confusion, yet instantaneously—somewhat as you can do now when you call to mind a story you have read and know well.

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- When you say "David Copperfield," you mean all the Davids, in order, but you see them all at once, from the young David to the old David, because, having finished the story, you are outside it.
- You are "after death" regarding David. One day you will be "after death" regarding yourself. Time now confines us. There is never enough of it. I think heavenly time will be like heavenly space: fully humanized and subject to the soul. Even now there are two kinds of time, as there are two kinds of space (space and place): *chronos*, or chronological time, material time, and *kairos*, or lived time, human time, time for some purpose measured by mind and will. Now, *kairos* is contained and constrained by *chronos*; there is seldom enough time to do justice to anything. In heaven this inside-out situation will be reversed, and chronological time will be contained and mastered by *kairos*, somewhat as even now playwrights and novelists master the time in their stories.
- Our dissatisfaction with time, by the way, is a powerful piece of evidence that we are made for eternity. There is nothing more natural and all-pervasive in this world than time. Not only our bodies but our souls as well are immersed in time. Yet we complain about it. C. S. Lewis asks, "Do fish complain of the sea for being wet? Or if they did, would that fact not strongly suggest that they had not been, or were not destined always to be, aquatic creatures?" We long to step out of the sea of time onto the land of eternity, even though we do not really understand what eternity is!
- Yet in a sense everyone will be both old and young, as a reflection of the God who is the Alpha and Omega, oldest and youngest, "beauty ancient yet ever new."

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• treasures and rewards Social justice. It's a pain in the Christian back side, but it seems to be a thing that Jesus is about.

<sup>MT 6:19</sup> "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. <sup>20</sup> But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. <sup>21</sup> For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

• it appears most of our treasure stored up in heaven will be by acts done anonymously where only God sees the motive while others experience the acts of love...

MT 5:11 "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. <sup>12</sup> Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

MT 5:43 "You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' <sup>44</sup> But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, <sup>45</sup> that you may be sons of your Father in heaven. He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. <sup>46</sup> If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? <sup>47</sup> And if you greet only your brothers, what are you doing more than others? Do not even pagans do that? <sup>48</sup> Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

MT 6:1 "Be careful not to do your `acts of righteousness' before men, to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven.

MT 6:2 "So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by men. I tell you the truth, they have received their reward in full. <sup>3</sup> But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, <sup>4</sup> so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

MT 6:5 "And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by men. I tell you the truth, they have received their reward in full. <sup>6</sup> But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

MT 10:42 And if anyone gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones because he is my disciple, I tell you the truth, he will certainly not lose his reward."

MT 16: 26 What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeits his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? <sup>27</sup> For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what he has done.

<sup>EPH 6: 7</sup> Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not men, <sup>8</sup> because you know that the Lord will reward everyone for whatever good he does, whether he is slave or free.

<sup>COL 3: 23</sup> Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, <sup>24</sup> since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

#### and there will be activities...

There will be activities in heaven to engage man's highest faculties. For one thing, there will be governmental ministries. The "spirits of just men made perfect" (Hebrews 12:23) will be in the "city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to the company of many thousands of angels" (Hebrews 12:22), and men are to assist in governing the whole. Thus in the parable of the nobleman the good servant, who has been "faithful in a very little" on earth, is in heaven to be given "authority over ten cities" (Luke 19:17). In Matthew the servant who had been given five talents and who had "gained beside them five talents more" is told: "Well done, thou good and faithful servant:... I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord" (Matthew 25:20-21). Perhaps new songs are to be written and sung (Revelation 5:9). The

"redeemed from the earth," too, are to learn a "new song" (Revelation 14:3). And the kings of the earth are to "bring their glory and honour into it" (Revelation 21:24). So while there is to be on the part of the redeemed a continuous worship in heaven, it seems to be in the sense that all activities engaged in will be for the sole glory of God and will therefore partake of the nature of worship.
