## So lets talk a little about this immeasurably more than what we can imagine destination...

NLT REV 21: 15 The angel who talked to me held in his hand a gold

measuring stick to measure the city, its gates, and its wall. <sup>16</sup> When he measured it, he found it was a square, as wide as it was long. In fact, its length and width and height were each 1,400 miles. <sup>17</sup> Then he

measured the walls and found them to be 216 feet thick (according to the human standard used by the angel).

### The city is cube shape...

- The angel who talked with John had a measuring rod of Pure Gold to measure the city, its gates and its walls. 1400 mile gold measuring tape...impressive
- The city was laid out like a square as long as it was wide.
- How large is the city? That varies slightly depending on the version of the Bible. The ESV and NIV and NLT versions say it translates to 1,400 miles, The KJV and some other versions say translate to 1,500 miles.
- Regardless of whether the city is 1,400 miles or 1,500 miles in length and width, These measurements are meant to be literal since they are described as man's measurements (Rev. 21:17).
- The city a somewhat larger than 1/2 the size of the United States.
   Show slide of USA
- The New Jerusalem is all the square footage anyone could ask for. We don't need to worry that Heaven will be crowded.
- The ground level of the city will be nearly two million square miles.
- Even more astounding than the size at the base is the height that is also at least 1,400 miles(Rev. 21:16).
- The top of the cube... is what would be called the sky line... that is where the sky touches and obeject... the sky touches the New Jerusalem 1400 hundred miles in the stratosphere...
- The walls that high brings up an interesting observation...the highest mountain on this earth ...Mt Everest is close to 6

- miles.... Commercial planes fly ay 6-8 miles high...
- So This goes well beyond Earth's atmosphere and into space. this would take person into the stratosphere to go to the top....
- So our bodies combined with our spirit bodies will have some significant capabilities we currently do not..
- And He also measured the wall 216 feet thick or 72 yards

\*\*\*\*lets get an idea of what the size of this city would look like on our current earth... 2)Show slide of cube on top of earth...

- One estimate of the total number of humans that have ever lived on this planet puts the figure at around 106.5 billion.
- For the sake of argument, if we assume each and every one gets a place in the city, that leaves enough room for everyone to have property that consists of at least 72 acres
- In other words, it seems there will be more than enough room for everyone.
- If you are 1 mile away from the city, you would not see the top... but might if you are 10 miles away.
- In the total square miles of the Cube you could place 80 earths worth of land mass!

NLT REV 21: 18 The wall was made of jasper, and the city was pure gold, as clear as glass.

• The wall was made of Jasper which is brownish and translucent, Which is like Crystal so clear you can almost see through it. it lets light thru but you cannot see clearly through it...

- The city was of Pure God, as pure as Glass. ... Gold is the most soft and pliable of all metals; a single ounce can be beaten into a sheet covering 300 square feet
- Gold leaf can be beaten thin enough to become translucent again letting light through but not transparent...translucent ....
- The gold that John saw in heaven was of such quality that it appears are so translucent you can almost see through them.
- While man pursues treasures like gold on earth, one day it will simply be no more than a source of pavement for the streets in heaven and precious stones are on the walls...

#### 2) Show slide of the gates and foundation...

NLT 21:12 It had a great, high wall with twelve gates, and with twelve angels at the gates. On the gates were written the names of the twelve tribes of Israel. <sup>13</sup> There were three gates on the east, three on the north, three on the south and three on the west. <sup>14</sup> The wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

- The foundation of the walls are layered... for 1400 miles...
- Then There were twelve gates each gate was made out of a single pearl. The city street was made from pure gold Like transparent glass. Pearl how big would an oyster have to be? and what is shining through this cities gates and wall?

NLT REV 21: 22 I saw no temple in the city, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. 23 And the city has no need of sun or moon, for the glory of God illuminates the city, and the Lamb is its light. 24 The nations will walk in its light, and the kings of the world will enter the city in all their glory.

• the light from God the uncreated light...Jesus the visible light...the lamp.. is so bright it lights up everything inside and outside the city...

NLT JN 8: 12 Jesus spoke to the people once more and said, "I am the light of the world. If you follow me, you won't have to walk in darkness, because you will have the light that leads to life."

• and kings and nations of believers will stream to it and will bring their best into it...

- If the cube was set down on the United States with one side touching the West Coast would Stretch east to the Appalachian Mountains and would touch to the north Canada and to the touch the border of Mexico.
- He measured the City with the rod and found it to be 12,000 stadia in length and as wide and high as it was long.
- A Stadia -. 607 to 630 feet long...12000 x 625 equals about 1400-1500 miles A very similar length is the modern *furlong*, or eighth of a mile, 660 ft.

• The cube shape of the New Jerusalem reminds us of the cube shape of the Most Holy Place in the Temple (1 Kings 6:20), the three dimensions perhaps suggestive of the three persons of the Trinity. God will live in the city, and it is his presence that will be its greatest feature.

1 Kings 6:19 He prepared the inner sanctuary within the temple to set the ark of the covenant of the Lord there. 20 The inner sanctuary was twenty cubits long, twenty wide and twenty high. He overlaid the inside with pure gold, and he also overlaid the altar of cedar.
